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Memphis Tigers lose the final regular season to Navy and also the Coach

MEMPHIS- The Memphis Tigers football team celebrated Senior Day on Thanksgiving against conference rival Navy at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium. It turned out to be a Navy celebration as they took down the Tigers 28-17. It was the 3rd straight loss for the Tigers. They did not have a win in November and ended the season 8-4.

The Tigers had a 17-14 lead going into halftime. However, they could not stop Navy's running game in the 2nd half. Navy ran for 154 yards after only run-

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Trump admin. enacts FPC Proposal to create DOJ 2nd Amendment Rights section

December 1, 2025- Firearms Policy Coalition (FPC) welcomed reports that the Trump Administration will establish a dedicated Second Amendment rights section within the Civil Rights Division of the Department of Justice—an action that directly reflects FPC’s top executive-branch recommendation and a priority first proposed by FPC during the previous Trump Administration. The new office is expected to officially ramp up in early December.

FPC has consistently called for the creation of such a legal arm

as part of a broader, long-term strategy to challenge and dismantle unconstitutional state and local restrictions on the right to keep and bear arms. The new section represents a vital infrastructure piece needed to confront what FPC has described as the ‘Axis of Authoritarianism’—governments that continue to defy Supreme Court precedent and block the exercise of fundamental rights.
