New SAF TV campaign warns about the Kamala Harris’ gun ban agenda

The Second Amendment Foundation (SAF) is launching a new national TV advertisement warning about Vice President Kamala Harris’ anti-gun intentions, and the effort to push Joe Biden’s gun control agenda before he leaves office.

“Not only are we reminding America that radical Second Amendment-hating politicians have said repeatedly that ‘nobody is coming after your guns,’ but now we’re warning that Biden and Harris want to move fast, to accomplish that very thing,” said SAF founder and Executive Vice President Alan M. Gottlieb. “It is imperative we get this message out, now that Biden is leaving office and Harris is the presumed nominee to replace him in the presidential campaign. “Now that Kamala Harris has entered the spotlight, she takes full ownership of the Biden-Harris gun ban plan,” Gottlieb stated. “Last year she was appointed to be the administration’s ‘gun czar’

overseeing the White House Office of Gun Violence Prevention. Let’s hope she’s been as inefficient at doing that as she’s been as the ‘border czar.’ In the past she has advocated for mandatory buy-back programs, semi-auto bans, universal background checks which translate to national gun registration, and more. It’s our job to warn the public about her record.”

The new 60-second message once again highlights Biden’s comments during a CNN Town-hall broadcast when he admitted he wants to ban not only modern semiautomatic rifles, but 9mm pistols as well. They are the two most popular types of firearms in the United States today, and mil-

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lions of law-abiding citizens own them.

“This is the 18th national TV spot SAF has run as part of our legacy of liberty campaign,” Gottlieb said. “We have run more national television advertising than any other Second Amendment advocacy group since Joe Biden took office because it is imperative we educate the public about this ongoing threat to their fundamental rights.”

SAF’s new 60-second message will appear on the following networks: Fox News, Fox Biz, CNN, MSNBC, HLN, Weather Channel, CNBC, Bloomberg, BBC America, World Fishing, History Channel, TBN, AHC, Outdoor Channel, Game Show, RFD, OANN, Direct TV and DISH TV, as well as others. The SAF ad urges viewers to call 800-241-4882 and join the fight to prevent the Biden-Harris gun grabbing agenda from becoming a reality.

seen by millions of children and minors. The obscene/indecent content occurred during a portion of the ceremonies that mocked Jesus Christ and the Last Supper. The Olympics was forced to issue an apology over the content. According to the FCC, “federal law prohibits obscene, indecent and profane content from being broadcast on the radio or TV.” The FCC further states: Obscene content does not have protection by the First Amendment. For content to be ruled obscene, it must meet a three-pronged test established by the Supreme Court: It must appeal to an average person’s prurient interest; depict or describe sexual conduct in a “patently offensive” way; and, taken as a whole, lack serious literary, artistic, political or scientific value.

It is a violation of federal law to air obscene programming at any time. It is also a violation of federal law to broadcast indecent or profane programming during certain hours. Under 18 U.S.C. Section 1464, “[w]hoever utters any obscene, indecent, or profane language by means of radio communication shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than two years, or both.” Under 18 U.S.C. Section 1468(a)...

Indecent content portrays sexual or excretory organs or activities in a way that is patently offensive but does not meet the three-prong test for obscenity.

Profane content includes “grossly offensive” language that is considered a public nuisance. The FCC notes airing obscene or indecent content is a federal crime:

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Ahead of the opening ceremony of the Paris Olympic Games, U.S. Senator Marsha Blackburn (R-Tenn.) led a bipartisan group of her Senate colleagues in introducing a resolution expressing support for the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic teams competing in the summer games:

This resolution is endorsed by the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC).

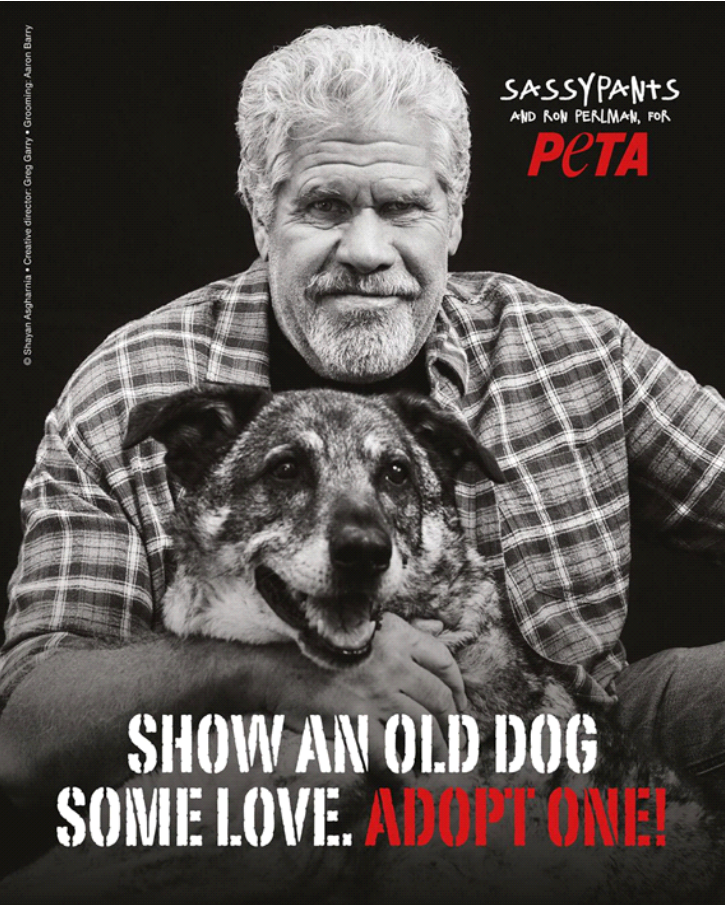
