Main Line Armory garners NSSF’s Five-Star range rating; Armory founded by veterans eager to serve their community

DECEMBER 1, 2025 - NSSF®, The Firearm Industry Trade Association, has awarded Main Line Armory with its coveted Five-Star rating for range excellence. Five stars is the highest rating in NSSF’s star-rating system, which evaluates shooting facilities based on appearance, management, shooting sports development and amenities. Main Line Armory is a 30,000-square-foot destination luxury indoor range located in Malvern, Pennsylvania — the western end of the historic Pennsylvania Railroad’s Philadelphia “Main Line.” Main Line Armory was founded in 2020 by veterans eager to serve their local community through training and an elevated customer experience, opening in 2023.

“Main Line Armory is well deserving of a Five-Star rating for range excellence. They meet all the marks (and then some) within the rating system which evaluates ranges based on Appearance, Management, Shooting Sports Development and



Amenities,” said Zach Snow, NSSF Director, Member Development. “The residents of Malvern and the surrounding areas are very fortunate to have such a first-class facility in their community to learn, build their skill-sets and connect with others who enjoy the shooting sports.” Inspired by local history and its proximity to Valley Forge and

other significant sites, Main Line Armory incorporated elements of the Revolutionary War into its branding and throughout the facility. Three, 25-yard bays are named after Revolutionary War Generals who frequented the Main Line of Philadelphia. “We knew that if we were going to create an indoor range that truly appealed to our local com-

munity, we couldn’t just build something modern. The space needed classic, timeless design elements that made people feel at home the moment they walked in. For many, this industry can feel intimidating — and we wanted to change that,” said Greg and Katie Butler, Main Line Armory Founders. Main Line Armory has 21 state-

of-the-art firing lanes, featuring custom LED lighting, touch-screen target controls and programmable scenarios. Range guests can practice with precision using 360-degree rotating targets and red/blue track-mounted lighting, simulating real-life scenarios. For guests seeking an exclusive experience,

there is a five-lane private VIP shooting bay. Additionally, this facility is the only indoor shooting range in the Malvern area to offer a fresh-air ventilation system. Membership is a key growth segment at Main Line Armory, which currently boasts more than

Second Amendment as protecting a real right that warrants the same institutional protection as all other enumerated rights. FPC also emphasized the importance of appointing leadership with deep expertise in original-public-meaning jurisprudence to ensure that the new section’s work remains faithful to the Constitution, as recommended in FPC’s White House briefing.

Said FPC President Brandon Combs about the new DOJ office, “This is a great move by the Trump Administration. Gun owners certainly have something to be thankful for this year.” FPC urged the Administration to ensure that the new section is fully integrated with the nation’s leading Second Amendment litigation groups and subject-matter experts, maintaining tight alignment with established long-term strategy, legal theory, and ongoing

ing high-impact constitutional cases.

“If this new section is led by genuine Second Amendment litigation experts, faithfully grounded in the original public meaning of the Constitution, and fully coordinated with the groups and firms already driving the long-term strategy, this could be a significant step forward for the fight for liberty and the right to keep and bear arms,” Combs explained. “There is already a strong long-term strategy being implemented across the country, so the DOJ should integrate and

partner rather than starting from scratch or going its own way.” While optimism is high, FPC noted that the DOJ continues—at this moment—to advance harmful and anti-originalist arguments in multiple ongoing cases, including efforts that would narrow or even reverse major Second Amendment victories protecting millions of peaceable Americans. FPC called on the Administration to immediately halt these contradictory litigation positions and begin supporting—rather than opposing—strong constitutional litigation that advances the very

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rights this new DOJ section is intended to protect.

“One of the new section’s first responsibilities should be to coordinate with litigators and support Supreme Court review in strong cases,” Combs said. “And the DOJ needs to realign its litigation

positions to stop undermining the very rights this new office is intended to safeguard. The DOJ must stop encouraging the Court to take up weak or strategically harmful cases and end its active opposition to pro-rights lawsuits already in progress.”

FPC looks forward to working with the Administration to ensure that the new DOJ section is structured for long-term success, led by advocates and experts committed to proper constitutional interpretation, and fully aligned with the strong national strategy to restore the right to keep and bear arms at all levels of government.

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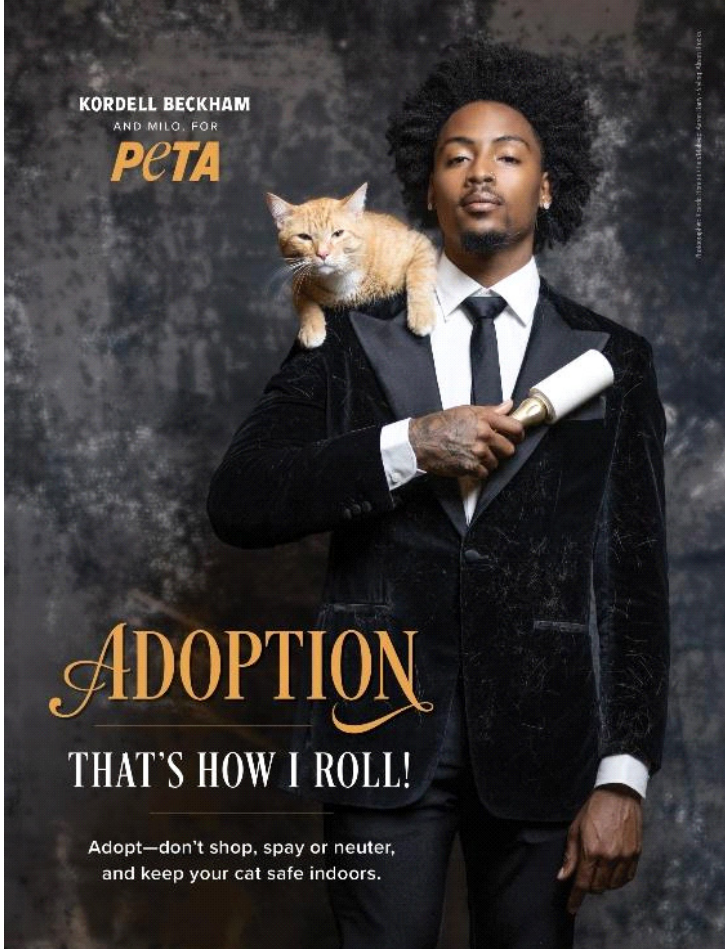
