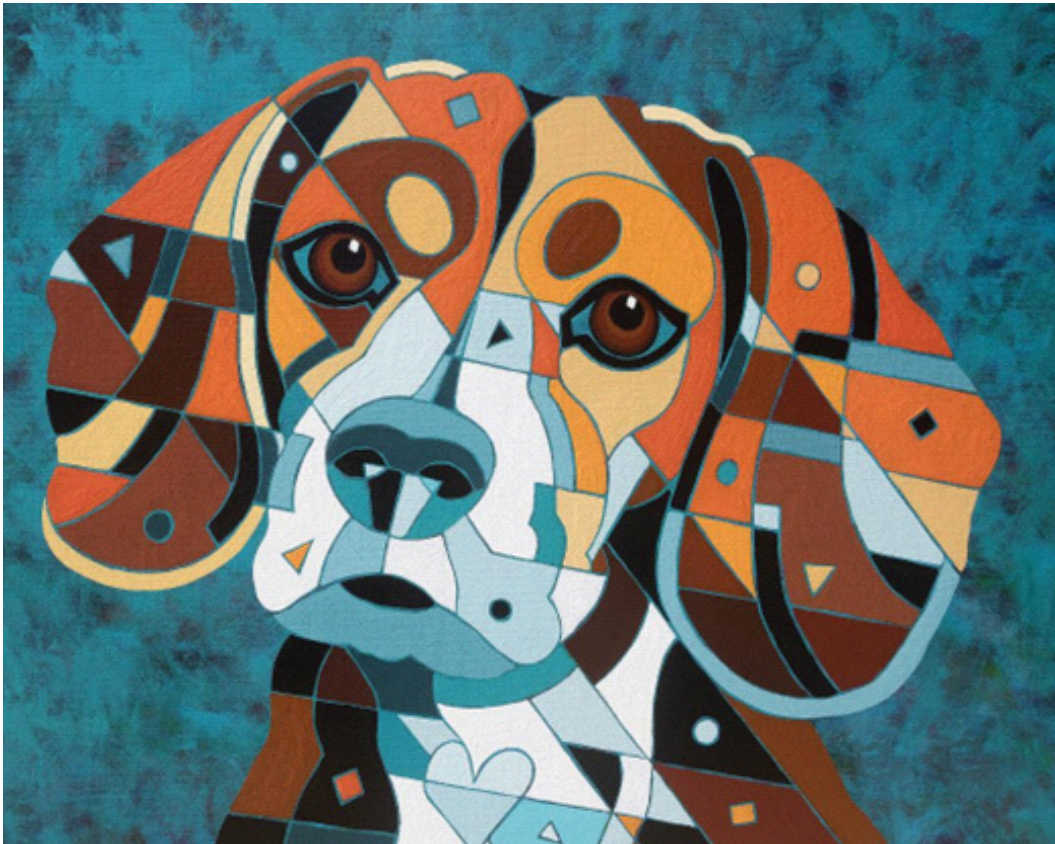

Shop & Support, a community group, presents an inaugural fundraising event benefitting WKNO Public TV and Media

MEMPHIS, TN, March 12, 2026 – Shop & Support, a newly-founded community group addressing issues facing the Memphis community, is happy to announce their first fundraiser supporting WKNO on Saturday, April 4, 2026 from 2-6 PM. With the recent elimination of federal funding across the country, the local public media station, WKNO, has been left with a shortfall of 21% (\$1.3 million) in this year’s operating budget.

Hosted at First Congregational Church (1000 Cooper St.), the vibrant event will consist of an outdoor thrift market, live music from local artists (**Parasoline,**

**Jeff Hulett,** and **Triceratops**) and food trucks (**Mempops** and **Top Dawgz**), with any and all proceeds going directly to WKNO.

Volunteers with the Shop & Support team are collecting clean, gently used men’s, women’s, and children’s clothing, books, CDs, records, jewelry, and toys from designated drop-off locations.

These items will be on sale to the public during the event on April 4. Drop-off locations to donate items include Novel book store in Laurelwood shopping center as well as the WKNO office in Cordova.
