Blake Watson named to Paul Hornung Award Honor Roll

MEMPHIS, Tenn. – University of Memphis running back Blake Watson was named to the Paul Hornung Award Honor Roll, the Paul Hornung Award, presented by Texas Roadhouse, announced on Tuesday. The Paul Hornung Award is presented annually to the most versatile player in major college football. In the Tigers’ 35-32 win over Boise State this past Saturday, Watson rushed 19 times for 113 yards and two touchdowns, while also catching two balls for 20 yards.

On the season, Watson leads the team with 455 rushing yards on 77 carries with six touchdowns and also ranks second on the team in receptions (26) and third in receiving yards (233) with another score.

Nationally, Watson ranks 11th in the FBS in total touchdowns (7), 14th in all-purpose yards (138.60), 15th in rushing touchdowns, 23rd in rushing yards and 24th in rushing yards per game (91.0).

The Memphis Tigers will host the Tulane Green Wave at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium on Friday, Oct. 13. The game is slated for a 6 p.m. start and will be televised nationally on ESPN. Single-game tickets for the 2023 Memphis Football season are available at GoTigersGo.com. Additionally, fans can also utilize a new ticket offering this season, allowing fans the choice of how to customize their gamedays at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium.

With the Flex Pack, fans can purchase six or more ticket vouchers starting at \$99, and from there, can choose how they would like to allocate their vouchers. through several areas, catching smallmouth on spots where he had yet to get a bite. But it was a return to his Day 1 starting spot that proved to be the difference, as he landed three bass close to 2 1/2 pounds in a 20-minute flurry during the early afternoon. “I was planning on hitting my main starting spot a bunch of times today. I knew what quality

lived there if I could just get a couple of bites,” he said. “As soon as I left that spot this morning, there were a bunch of catfish guys walking down the bank. About an hour later I came back by and there were trotlines and four bobbers littered on my point. I was like, ‘What is going on?’ I checked it two more times and they were still there.

“Finally, after the (midday) break they were gone and that’s when I stopped in there and caught the three upgrades, which ended up winning the tournament for me.” While Smith achieved a limit shortly after Fothergill and even led for a good portion of the mid-morning and early afternoon, the Auburn junior from

Shoal Creek, Ala., could not find a true kicker bass. Fothergill never knew what Smith had in his bag, but felt as though he needed one more bite to solidify his spot in the Bassmaster Classic. “I knew I had the biggest bag of my week, so I knew I made Tucker earn it if he did beat me,”

way to have a season ticket but experience a variety of the seating options FedExForum has to offer, and it also adds some fun to the days leading up to each game when you wait to see where you will be watching the action from this time.” Home games on Memphis’ 2023-24 slate include Vanderbilt (Dec. 23), Clemson (Dec. 16) and Virginia (Dec. 19), along with American Athletic Conference matchups against Final Four participant Florida Atlantic (Feb. 25), UAB (March 3), Wichita State (Feb. 3) and Tulane (Feb. 11). Coming off an AAC Tournament title, a second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance and a fifth consecutive 20-win season, Memphis head coach Penny Hardaway brought in a top-15 class this season that features point guard and Alabama transfer Jahvon Quinerly, who scored over 1,100 points while winning two SEC regular season championships and two SEC tournament titles in his Crimson Tide career. The Tigers also reeled in the reigning Lou Henson Award winner in 6-foot-11 big man Jordan Brown, who averaged 19.3 points, 8.6 rebounds and grabbed

10 double-doubles for Louisiana en route to being named first team all-conference and the Sun Belt Tournament MVP. Another addition in the Tiger backcourt this season is Florida State transfer Caleb Mills, who started over 50 games for the Seminoles the last two seasons. In 2022-23, he averaged 13.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, a team-high 3.4 assists and 1.3 steals per game. Hardaway found another scorer in former Wichita State guard Jaykwon Walton, who led the Shockers with 13.9 points and 5.3 rebounds per game last season in 27 starts. Additionally, Memphis added another big-time player in St. John’s transfer David Jones. The 6-foot-6 forward started 17 games for the Red Storm last season, averaging 13.2 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. He logged seven double-doubles, rattled off double digits in 25 games and drained a team-high 42 triples.
